Nina Bondeson:

"Language and the world – report from a changed topography" is a lecture that Nina gave at the printmaking seminar "Printmaking in the expanded field" in Oslo, september 2015.

Conceptual art came with huge emancipatory ambitions in the beginning of the 1960's. A radical change was called for, but it totally subordinated the linguality in craft and material based art making. The emancipation for some turned into a colonization for others. What broke loose was an ordinary hegemonical struggle. So, how do we, as printmakers, deal with this struggle today? Does it still affect us? What would an updated topography of the expanded field look like?

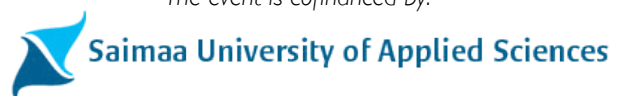

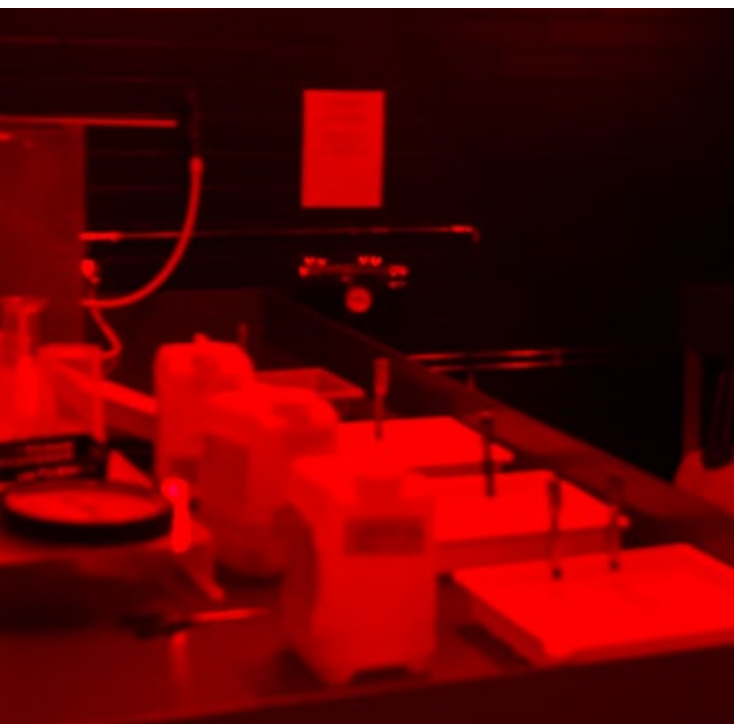


Nordic Culture Point
